 said parish & to be arranged for at Easter next by the said churchwardens.

Agreed that the Minister and parishioners of the said parish do nominate
 Edward Condit Matthew Martin of Sego Elagh and
 John Willie of Knocknamagh to serve churchwardens for
 the said parish for this present year. It is likewise agreed at
 request of the parishioners & by the consent of the Minister that twenty oak
 boards fallen on the lands of Killinigan be to supply the parish church with
 shingles the old ones being very much decayed through long continuance
 It is likewise agreed that Patrick Morris & Thomas Bell shall be overseers
 of the high ways in the Brownlow proportion & that Thomas Drum
 and Timothy Luke be overseers of the highways in the command of Killybeg
 Tho. Drum for the high ways & Timothy for the low ways & that
 Thomas Dorington John Lindsay be overseers of the high ways of the
 Manor of Glenties the said Tho. Dorington for that part leading from Killybeg
 to Lillo & from Glenties to Killybeg & John Lindsay for that
 leading from Glenties to Buncanny gate & the church way leading
 from Dromnohally to Sego
