 that John Dwyer & Thomas Crumblie be assessors of the High way  
 of the manor of Lurne And that William Dickson & John  
 Brinkley be assessors of the High ways in the manor of  
 Corbrackoge for this year also James Walker is discharge  
 of what money remained in his hands of the former church (off)

At a Vestry holden in the Parish Church  
 of Sego, for the said Parish, upon Easter  
 Monday the eight & twentieth day of March  
 1692.

It is agreed that the Minister and Parishioners of the said Parish  
 do nominate elect & constitute Mr Patrick Morris of Killenerget  
 and William Arran of Larn to serve as Churchwardens  
 for the said Parish for this present year. It is likewise  
 agreed that John Abraham of Berradoo & Richard Mason of  
 Tormery shall serve as overseers of the highway leading  
 from Drumgore river to the foot of the hill near M. Loo  
 Dwyer his house, according to former divisions; and Timothy  
 Kirk for the lower way of the manor of Larnan, and  
 Thomas Rogers for the upper way of the same manor; and  
 Thomas Fearclo & John MacConnell for the high ways of  
 Corbrackoge, all according to former divisions.
