I have borrowed the old Church Bible for which Mr Richard Timm would give 18s per. & lent a new Bible in folio to the Church at cost 1:8 sterling. Beside I have bought a new Common Prayer Book for the Churches use, and have left it in the Church, which cost me 7s per. And I have set up a table of unlawful marriages according the 47th Canon which cost me a shilling or 6d for the printed paper & 6d for the frame; And I have provided a Book of Canon for the Church which ordinarily costs 1s per. June the 8th 1695.

At a Vestry holden in the Parish of Segoe for the Parish on the 13th day of April 1696

By the Consent of the Minister and Parsonages then present It is agreed that Thomas Haysen of Drumankells and William Erwin of Carno are elected and chosen to serve as Churchwardens for this next year; and that the sum of term pounds shob. be equally apportioned upon and levied of the Inhabitants of the Parish by the Churchwardens to buy a flagg of the Church, for a flagon of black tin, cloaths of linnen & woollen for the Communion table & a fringe and for a large napkin for the women and for repairs of the Church & other necessary charges to be accounted for next year.
