

At a vestry holden for the Parish of Sege in the Parish Church the 24<sup>th</sup> day of August 1699.

It was agreed and enacted by the Minister Churchwarden and Parishioners then present that the sum of six pounds per be appointed upon the Parish and levied by the Churchwardens for the buying of a silver Patten for the Administration of the Lords Supper, and to maintain a child left in the townland of Baltea, whose name cannot be discovered; and together with the sum of ten pounds agreed upon at the last vestry make the sum of sixteen pounds per to be levied by the present Churchwardens for which they are to account with the Parish at Easter next.

At a vestry holden in the Parish Church of Sege on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of September 1699

It was then enacted by the Churchwardens and the Parishioners then present that the sum of fifteen pounds per be appointed on and levied off of the inhabitants of the Parish by the Churchwardens of the Parish (viz) four pounds per for building a bellfrow of Brick and eleven pounds per more for a Bell to be levied at Easter next.
