At a vestry holden in y^e parish Church of Sogo on y^e Monday
being y^e 29th day of March 1703

It was then enacted by y^e Minister Church wardens and
Parishoners then present that y^e sum of five pounds five shilling
to be apportioned upon the Parishoners & land holders of y^e Parish
(viz) one pound & fifteen shillings for elements for y^e holy communion
and three pounds & ten shillings for necessary repairs of y^e Church
And that Anthony Motealf of Sogo son and Henry Esq^r of Drangaffe
and Chapen Church wardens and David Williams of Bally Hanaghan
and William Mason of Drumanshells p^resident for y^e year ensuing
Jacob Robson to be overseer of y^e highways from Donderr to Kilsorgan
River. Robert Wright from Kilsorgan to Mr Dynohill & from
the blow fane to y^e high way leading to Kilsorgan & from Kilsorgan to
the Church. William Drom to continue, Robert Black & William Cuthan
to survey from y^e Road in Ballymacramoll to y^e road at Kilsorgan and
from John Binkor to upper fogs gate; Robert Mason to survey from Mr
Dynohill to William Williams bridge & from Shankill Church stile to y^e
Kilsorgan River.
