

Jan: 3^d 1703 / ¹⁶⁴ At a Vestry then held in the Parish Church of Iego it was
 unanimously agreed, y^t whereas there was an Act of Vestry made y^e 25th
 day of Aprile. Anno Domini 1700 wherein it was ordered & agreed y^t twenty
 pounds ster: should be apportioned & levied off y^e said Parish for a Bell & Belfry.
 wh^{ch} sum^{me} of money was according to apportioned & levied; ^{but} afterwards it appa-
 ring more necessary y^t a Gallery should be built in y^e first place. Another
 Act of Vestry was made y^e 6th of Apr: 1702. wherein it was agreed y^t y^e said money
 should be applyed to y^e building of y^e said Gallery & other uses in y^e said Act mentioned.
 after this y^e Revd Mr John Campbell acquainted y^e Right Revd y^e L^o Bp of
 y^e Diocese y^t y^e said money was so applyed as aforesaid, but y^t y^e ^{like sum} ~~money~~ was
 promised by y^e Parishioners to be forthcoming for y^e Bell & Belfry as
 it was first intended. We therefore y^e minister Churchwardens & parson
 next met do accordingly agree y^t y^e sum^{me} of 20 be apportioned
 & levied with all convenient speed ^{betwixt y^e damonay ponds} the said money being intended for
 a Bell & Belfry as ~~first~~ ^{intended} formerly by agreed.
