on Easter Monday the 17th of April 1704.

It was then agreed & enacted by the Minister Churchwarden
and Parishioners then present, that the sum of five pounds
per be allotted upon the Parishioners & Levied of
them, viz one pound fifteen shillings for Elements
for the Lord's Supper, and three pound five shillings
for the Repairs of the Church.

Robert Wilson of Terryenvir & Valentime
Dines of Tanafyglassy are chosen Churchwardens
for the ensuing year. The overseers,

Joseph Harry to be overseer of the high ways from
Edanderry to Silvergan River.

Meredith Dines to oversee the way from Killecamam
to Mr Dines' hill, and from the blue stone to the
causeway leading to Ballynacor mill, & from Killecamam
to the Church; John Abraham from the
Bardfoot to the stone bridge in Terryencast.

William Freer & John Bink from Knockbridge to
Lile and thro Killecamam to upper Sejo gate.

Roger Webb to survey from Mr Dines' hill to William
Williamson's bridge, and from Shankill Church to Silvergan
River.
