Thomas Stevenson of Taneyheyglason for William  
Walley to oversee from Killycomaine to Mrs Dyne  
hill, and from the Blue Stone to Ballynecon Mill;  
Robert Wilson at the band foot, and James Simonson to  
serve instead of ~~Robert~~ James Kocally;  
John Walley for Mr. Francis Malher;  
Robert Thomson Constable; John Web Constable,  
William Dixon and William Roby for the Church way  
leading from Ballyntranel through Killycomaine and  
the Queen's road.
