

At a vestry holden in the Parish Church of Jago on
the 9th Day of August 1708

It was agreed by the Minister Churchwarden and parish
oners then present that the sum of 01-02-03
together with a sum of 01-17-04

Be Levied of the parishioners and land holders of
the said parish, for the Repair of the porch and
building of a stile of stone and lime below
the gate of the Church-yard for a convenience
for women to get on horse backs and other
uses mentioned in a former Act, to be
Raised by the present Churchwarden by
distress or other wise according to Law,
the work to be done immediately and
accounted for at Easter next
