

At a vestry held in the Parish Church of Segoe on Easter Monday
March the 30th 1719

It was enacted concluded and agreed upon by the Minister Church-wardens, and Parishioners then present that the sum of 5-13-8
be allotted and Levied of the Parishioners and Land holders of the
said Parish by distress or otherwise according to Law to
go together with 3-15-4 in the Churchwardens hands
make the sum of 9-8-0 for the uses
following ways for this ensuing year - 2-0-0
Articles and Charges - 1-0-0
Accidental Charges - 3-0-0
Elements for the Holy Communion - 3-0-0
for providing Elements - 0-6-0
for washing the surplice - 0-7-6
for washing the stables Linnen - 0-2-0
for collecting the Bess - 0-5-6
for allotting the Bess - 2-2-0

And that Henry Dorey of Kinnego and William McGosen
of Ballymacranel are chosen Churchwardens to serve for
this present year and that Richard Mene of Drumhughilly
and James Stone are chosen Overseers for the year
Jammell Robson of Drumneegan to oversee from Kilvirgin
River to Ganderrey, and from the Church to Killeomanine
Edward Wday of Terbiener, and Owen McKaine
to oversee from the Bann foot to widows Lindsay,
Robert Thompson, and John Bell continue
George Joyce, and George Blicke to oversee
from Knock Bridge to Ly Cow, and from William
Bullocks to John Binker, George Dilworth continue
on John Mather continue
