Dyns Hill to Kallcomaine and from y<sup>e</sup> Blew Stone to the Low Mill; Robert Comer of Deriadda; and Daniel Cattle of Bellymary are to serve for the Mayntagh Constable wick; Owen Mc Grath; and Thomas Wallock Continew to oversee from Knock Bridge to Lyle; and from Henry Black to John Binkes.
