

At a vestry holden in the parish Church of Sege the 24th day of August 1727

Whereas at a former act of Vestry holden in the parish Church of Sege Easter Monday the 2^d of April 1727 it was agreed upon by the Minister Churchwardens and parishioners then present that the sum of four pounds should be levied of the parishioners for making pillars and a new gate for the Church yard, which sum is found to be insufficient for doing the said work it is therefore enacted by the Minister Churchwardens and parishioners that the sum of seven pounds be levied for perfecting the said work, and for making a new wheel for the bell which with the former mentioned sum of four pounds amounts to eleven pounds for which sum is to be raised by distress or otherwise according to law
