

At a vestry held in the Parish Church
of Sege held for the Parish on the 12th
day of October 1730

It was agreed upon by the Minister Church
wardens and Parishoners then present
that the undernamed persons shall serve
over fees of the Highways in the
Parish of Sege (viz)
Mr Leonard Cross to oversee from Mr Duns
Hill to Killecormaine; and from the Glen
Stone to G. Low Mill, Anthony Medcalf
of upper sego from Killvirgin to Den-
ceby or Joan Dewy and Thomas
McKowan continue in Ballynemony
Constable Wick. William McKinney
and James Simonton are chosen to over-
see from the Bann foot to Devi-
Macash and halfe way from that to
the great Rode; John Hewitt and
John Vollen to oversee from Knock
Bridge to Lyle and from Newy blocks
to upper sego and from the great road
in Genderry to upper sego
