

Where as William Mather late of Dringora  
 in the Parish of Sege and County Ardsmagh  
 has purchased one seat in the Church of  
 Sege standing in the front of the gallery  
 from John Mather late of Killecomane  
 for which seal the said William Mather  
 has an Article from the sd. John Mather  
 which is entered in in the vestry book of  
 Sege by consent of the Minister Church-  
 wardens and Parishoners present  
 These are there for to certify that I  
 the sd. William Mather has sold and made  
 over to Robert Blacker of Edendery  
 one third part of the sd. seat to him  
 and his heirs for ever in Lew of a sum  
 of Money received by me from the said  
 Robert Blacker: as witness My hand this  
 first day of May 1731. William Mather.

I protest against the entering  
 the above as done by act of vestry  
 the above mentioned seat being  
 annexed to the freehold of the said  
 entered in this vestry book by consent of the  
 Minister Church wardens and Parishoners then  
 present this first day of May 1731

At a vestry held in the Parish Church of Sege  
 held for the sd. Parish on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October  
 1731 It was concluded and agreed upon by the  
 Minister Church-wardens and Parishoners then  
 present that the undernamed Persons shall  
 serve overseers of the highways in the  
 said Parish ~~for this~~ for this ensuing year  
 viz Arthur Jordan in Leonard Cross place  
 to oversee the road ~~from the~~ ~~to~~  
 and William Williams to oversee the Road  
 from Partadown to Williamsons Bridge  
 and that the following towns work at the said  
 Road by the six days work (viz) Edendery  
 upper and lower Levaghary Killecomane  
 Lisnague Kilmorra Ballyhamon Lylo Lis-  
 trominty Ballygargan Ballymacrannal  
 Cross M'Kanghilly Mareverky Dringora  
 Dringaskin Carroll Knocknagagh upper Sege  
 Kernon Balteagh <sup>Knocknagagh</sup> Dringecanvey Bally-  
 raghey John Gilpin to oversee from Kilvirgin  
 to Edendery and the undernamed towns to work by  
 the six days work viz Lower Sege, Stassen Carne  
 Ballyneer, Stassen Carrilt Terryware Dring-  
 negowen Kilvirgin. Mather Hewitt to oversee from  
 Kilvirgin River to Lurgan Parish and from the great Road  
 to Derlimacash Bridge the Constable <sup>to oversee</sup>  
 the said Road except Kilvirgin, William McKimney  
 and James Simington to oversee from the Bann foot to  
 Ballymacash the Moyilagh townlands to work at  
 the said Road except Derrittagh and Slinty  
 which is to work at the Road from Kerne to the side of  
 Devitashna Richard Timmons overseer. John <sup>to oversee</sup>  
 to oversee from Knock bridge to Lylo and from Henry  
 blocks to Sege Church. And it is taken and agreed  
 by the persons afore said that Mendick workman  
 Esq. was chosen Director over the said overseer  
 of the townlands of Ineagh Carrick Dringecanvey  
 Knock Aughneby Ballydonaghy Knockremuckey and to  
 work under John Lutton at the Road appointed to him  
 Robert Blacker Arthur Jordan
