 take an account of the Number of Acres in each
 townland in Mr Blackers and Mr Harrison's Lands
 in the Parish of Sege and the value of each
 Acre in the said Lands and give account to
 the Churchwardens at the next vestry held
 in the said Parish

And that Richard Timmons doe the Like in
 the Manner of Kernon

and Robert Thompson of Boconnal doe the
 Like in the Manner of Constable Wick of Kelly-
 meymony and the Moyntagh townlands
 and that the said Persons each of them doe
 the same through the whole Parish
 according to the Best of their Skill and Know-
 ledge and return an account at a vestry
 to be held in the Parish Church of Sege this
 day fourteen Night

and it is likewise agreed upon at the same
 time that the sum of five pound fifteen shillings
 and six pence due to John Gibson and agreed
 upon last Easter be applied and Levied of the
 Parish onery and Land holder of the said Parish
 and one pound eleven shillings be Levied for Repaire
 of the Church and for buying one common prayer
 Book; and one Register book for the use of the
 Parish
