Parish as formerly by the year's value
except the Manor of Hermon which
was equaliz'd by act of vestry; and
that the said Manor be pay its part of
the Chest accordingly as formerly
and that the whole be appoyled
by woollsey Sumnerphet immediately
the Church Chest laid on the Parish at
several times amounts to - 9 - 8 - 2
