 from Henry blocks to the great road in Killeicomaine
 and from thence to Borladown Bridge the whole

 ensuing year —
 And that the sum of seven pound six shill-
 ings be apploated and levied of the Parishoners and
 Land holders of the said Parish for the use of
 following (viz)
 Bell Mans wages for this ensuing year 2-0-0
 for Ellen and providing — 1-16-0
 Articles and Charges of Churchwardens — 0-16-0
 for washing the surplises and table linen — 0-12-8
 for a bang beger to take up strange beggers 2-0-0
 in the Parish of Sege — 0-2-2
 for apploating the Church Chest — 7-6-2
 and that this vestry is adjourned to the second
 of May Next.
