Tuesday, Dec. 29, 1891. The body of Mrs. Emma Elizabeth Seavin (aged 86 years) widow of the late Venble Archdeacon James Seavin, formerly Rector of Seago, was interred to-day in the vault under the Chancel. The tiling was lifted for this purpose, and the coffin was laid upon that of Archdeacon Seavin (interred in 1879). The coffin was borne into the Church, and to the vault by members of the Select Vestry. The following Clergy officiated: - Rev. A. D. Dawson, A. M. Rector, Rev. Robt. Quirk Curate; Rev. Aug. Fitzgerald D. D., Rector of Portadown; and Rev. Lewis Richards D. D. Rector of Downglap (Downganon). This was the last interment in the vault which was bricked up, and closed for ever.

Friday, Jan. 5, 1892. The Rev. A. Dawson, Rector of Seago, was on this day appointed to the Archdeaconry of Down, in succession to late Archdeacon Francis King D. D. (Incumbent of St. Patrick's, Newry), by Bp. Wm. Reeves D. D. Bp. of Down & former Down, who died on 12th January following.

Bp. Reeves thus restored to the Rectory of Seago the dignity of the Archdeaconry

of Drogheda which was connected with
League for at least 600 years, until
the then Bp. of Down (Knox), in 1879, ap-
pointed Rev. Henry Stewart D.D. Rec-
tor of Scapatiche (Bamburgh) there to
in succession to Archdeacon Gaurin.

On Wednesday, Feb. 10, 1892, Rev. A.
Dawson was instituted (His Grace the
Lud Primate (Dr. R. B. Knox) at the Palace
Armagh, during the vacancy of the See.
Mr. Dawson was installed in Drogheda
Cathedral, by the Very Rev. the Dean of
Drogheda (Dr. Campbell) on the following
Sunday 14th February.
