

On 18 June 1900 a Meeting of Select Vestry was held in Seago School house - The Very Rev. The Dean of Downmore in the Chair. Also present Rev. D. Quirk, Curate, Geo Calvert, John Montgomery Jas Albin, W. R. Atkinson.

It was decided to pay the Organist's Salary for 1899, the Dean having contributed £2 & £5 having been received from Collection on Sunday after dedication of Organ.

The Secretary was requested to arrange to have the Fire Insurance of Church & School house increased to a sufficient amount.

On 3 December 1900 a meeting of Select Vestry was held in Seago School house, The Very Rev. The Dean of Downmore in the Chair - Also present, Geo Calvert, Jas Collins, John Montgomery, Robert Nolley, Joseph Murray, Jas Albin & W. R. Atkinson. Proposed by Geo Calvert, seconded by James Collins that Mr. Nelson Irwin be elected to fill the vacancy on the Select Vestry arising from the lamented death of late Mr. Archd. Mackenzie.

The making of a boundary fence between the Parish lands and the property of Rev. Canon Blacker was discussed and the following Committee appointed to see same carried out in a satisfactory manner, on the proposal of W. R. Atkinson, seconded by Jas Albin, namely - Geo Calvert, Jas Collins, Nelson Irwin, Robert Nolley, Joseph Murray & W. R. Atkinson. The Dimensions of gripe to be  $3.6^{\text{ft}}$  and ditch  $3.0^{\text{ft}} \times 3.0^{\text{ft}}$ .

The above Committee was also appointed to superintend the erection of School master's house

Treasurer was requested to pay D. Quirk's Salary for 2 months ending 1 Dec 1900.

The following resolution was proposed by Nolley, W. R. Atkinson and seconded by James Albin and adopted unanimously - That the Select Vestry of Seago
